Where did we come from?

- 3 years flat line GSCE performance 20%
- Below national average
- High staff turnover
- High staff absence
- High level of exclusions
- Poor attendance
- Low standard of teaching & learning – Inconsistency
- Poor Leadership and management



Issues

- Deprivation Index – very high.
- High Pupil mobility – 50% Yr 11
- Low Parental Aspirations
- Poor Community Reputation
- 28% pupils on free school meals
- 34% pupils on SEN register

2009 – Where are we now?

- Exclusions down
50% over 24 months
- Staff attendance improved
- Teaching and learning
standards improved
- No of 1st choices pupils for
2008 was highest in Telford
