## PELSALL and SHELFIELD Crime Bulletin

Quite a lot of crime this month but our statistics are up due to the large amount of crime relating to damage and vandalism in our area.

We have received telephone calls from people concerning this, in particular from the Rushall area. The complaints have again been relating to groups of youths gathering and causing a nuisance. We ask once again, do you know where your children are at night? We assure you that most of these gang leaders are known and that some of the youths have already been spoken to by the Police at their homes and via schools.

There is to be a Neighbourhood Watch Scheme in our area. It is basically where we ask you to be a good neighbour by volunteering your name and address to the Community Watch Officer at Aldridge Police Station so that you may be contacted and informed of what it entails. Telephone Aldridge 54111.

In respect of last months crime, there have been no thefts from vehicles reported, but thefts of vehicles have occurred in Norton Road, Pelsall and Greenfields Road and Field Road, Sheffield.

There has only been one house entered which was in Hallbridge Close, Pelsall. It is reassuring from the fact that a good percentage of all other breaks this month have been detected.

Other breakins this month have been at the betting office, Rushall Square and Pelsall Comprehensive School together with Sheffield Comprehensive School.

Several Garages at Yenscroft and sheds at Clarendon Place and Pelsall Lane, Pelsall have also been burgled.

We have many cases of damage reported mainly caused by stone throwing. This has occurred in Old Mill Gardens and Sycamore Road, Sheffield, Rushall Surgery and damage to shop windows in Allens Lane and High Street, Pelsall.
